Happy Mother's Day

Today we thank our mothers, pray for them, honor them by celebrating Mother's Day and by offering our mothers on the altar of God.

This is a day to admit gratefully the fact that none of us is able to return, in the same measure, all the love that our mothers have given us. Their influence on their children is so great that it affects the children throughout their lives.
