Second Sunday of Advent

"Come home for Christmas"

"God will bring them back."—Baruch 5:6. Imagine your children being "led away on foot" by your enemies (Bar 5:6). Imagine your son handcuffed and led off to prison. What if your children were exiled in a foreign land and you would probably never see them again? This is similar to what the Jewish people went through at the Babylonian exile. About forty years later, Yahweh performed one of His greatest miracles. He freed the Jewish exiles, and they returned home. The Church brings this to our attention because this Christmas the Lord wants to bring our children home to Him. He wants those imprisoned and exiled to repent of their sins and to come to Him this Christmas. Come home to Jesus for Christmas. It makes all the difference in the world — and beyond the world.
