

NO MORE?

"They have no more wine." —John 2:3

We also say we have no more money, no more time, no more hope, peace, joy, etc. Although the Lord has promised to provide all our needs, we sometimes seem to be lacking our "daily bread".

When we have "no more," we should listen to Mary and do whatever Jesus tells us. If we simply obey Him, He will take the water of our insufficiency and transform it into the wine of His plenty.

Jesus has given us hundreds of commandments, and by His grace we can obey them all. At the center of all these commandments are those which Jesus gave us a few hours before His death on the cross. Jesus gave four commands at the Last Supper: Take, eat, drink, and do the Last Supper in memory of Him. If we do these commands, we will make present Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. From the crucified Christ, blood and water flow, providing the needs of all people. Do whatever Jesus tells you. Live the Mass. Make it the center of your life. Receive everything you need. Be deprived "no more."

The available positions include:

Family Advisor

This is a sales position in one of our six cemetery offices. The work includes guiding customers through the burial process, explaining the inground, cremation, and mausoleum options and costs, and prospecting for new customers. The compensation for this full-time position is a combination of salary and commission and includes benefits. Candidates should have sales experience in financial, insurance, medical, education, or similar fields. Office Administrator

Similar to a parish administrator, this position handles the office paperwork, scheduling, interment forms, and funeral home contacts. Current office and computer systems skills are necessary and it is a full-time salaried position with benefits.

Field Worker

This is a full-time, year-round salaried position with benefits. The work includes the opening/closing of graves, installation of memorials, markers, grounds maintenance, and landscaping.
