Pentecost Sunday Breathe on me

"All were filled with the Holy Spirit." —Acts 2:4

On this Pentecost Sunday, Jesus, Who is the same today as He was yesterday, is breathing on us and commanding us: "Receive the Holy Spirit." To receive the Spirit and thereby a renewal of our Baptisms and Confirmations, we must repent, forgive, and be forgiven. Then we will express ourselves "in foreign tongues and make bold proclamation as the Spirit" prompts us (Acts 2:4). We will see a miracle of unity.

As the divisions between races, nations, spouses, family members, and church members break down, the world will believe that God the Father has sent Jesus as the Savior of the world (Jn 17:21). The Holy Spirit will renew the face of the earth (Ps 104:30). Therefore, "come, Holy Spirit, come!... Heal our wounds, our strength renew; on our dryness pour Your dew; wash the stains of guilt away. Bend the stubborn heart and will; melt the frozen, warm the chill; guide the steps that go astray" (Pentecost sequence). Come, Holy Spirit of Pentecost!
