We Stand With Christ (WSWC) Project #1: Repair of Stained Glass Windows in Church – Completed.

This project was begun in September 2020, initially using the funds from our Parish savings, which were subsequently repaid when WSWC funds and parishioner donations started to arrive. The project was completed in September 2022.

The project involved removing old glass, cleaning the putty from the frames, and installing 31 new protective glasses. Then there were scraping and painting around 17 windows, installing and painting new stucco, sanding all the wood, new caulking, installing waterproof cement. Much of this work required renting scaffolding.

Financial Statement:

Expenses: \$45,989.34

Funding: \$20,245.00 (restricted donations from the Parishioners)

\$25,744.34 (from We Stand With Christ payments from the Diocese)

So far, we have received \$57,112.51 from the We Stand With Christ fund, with a little more than one year left in that 5 year campaign. After using \$25,744.34 of these funds for the Stained Glass Project, and minus monthly bank fees, we have \$31,368.17 to spend on our second project – a new handicapped ramp and bathroom for the Church – with more to come.

It is the outstanding generosity of our Parishioners that has enabled us to assure that the beauty of our Church will be maintained for the next generations. We are deeply grateful!
