On Sunday, January 22, 2023 at 11:00 am Mass Fr. Mark will be installed as pastor of Sacred Heart Parish. We have received many questions about the installation Mass, so are offering an overview along with an invitation!

When a new pastor is appointed for a parish, it is appropriate that he be publicly installed by a liturgical rite. Bishop Caggiano will be the celebrant of this rite. During the Installation Mass, the Bishop will invite the new pastor to be a loving father, gentle shepherd, and wise teacher to all.

The Rite of Installation

The new pastor is presented to the members of the lay trustees, parish council, finance council, and parish staff. After the Gospel, the Bishop presents the new pastor to the community, then gives the homily. Then the new pastor faces the people and leads the congregation in the profession of faith. After the profession of faith, the new pastor faces the bishop and recites an oath to believe in the teachings and tradition of the Church. This is followed by Prayers of Faithful, and Mass continues as normal.
