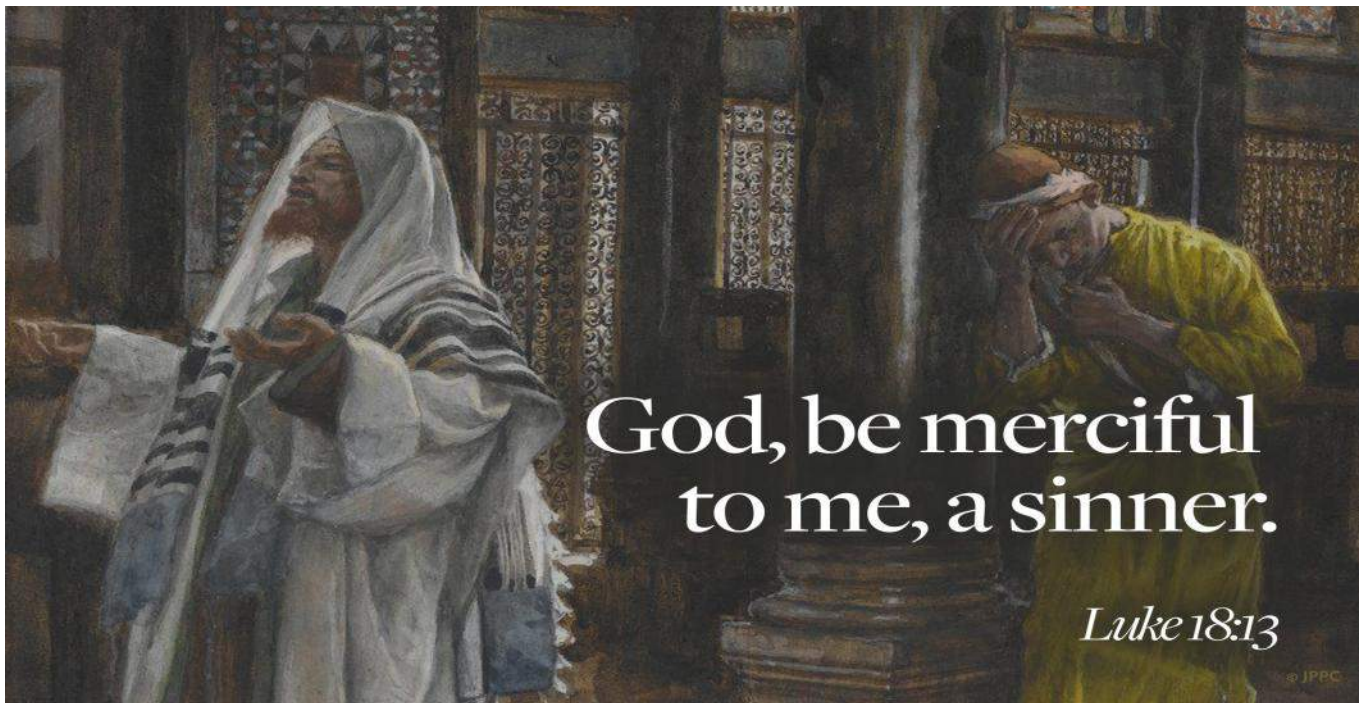

All the parents and the children of all grades are encouraged to participate in this beautiful celebration of the Eucharist every Sunday and manifest our faith in the Sacrament.

Important Information pertaining to Sunday Feasts in November 2025:

The first two Sundays in November this year welcome two feasts from the Proper of Saints: The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (Sunday, November 2nd) and The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica (Sunday, November 9th). These celebrations take precedence over a Sunday in Ordinary Time as they both outrank its liturgical grade. At the same time, the Solemnity of All Saints falls on Saturday, November 1st. The evening Mass of Saturday, November 1st is of All Saints', not of All Souls'. This year, All Saint's Day is **NOT** a Holy Day of Obligation.

Re: Sunday Feasts in November 2025
Date: October 9, 2025

The first two Sundays in November this year welcome two feasts from the Proper of Saints: *The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed* (Sunday, November 2nd) and *The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica* (Sunday, November 9th). These celebrations take precedence over a Sunday in Ordinary Time as they both outrank its liturgical grade. At the same time, *the Solemnity of All Saints* falls on Saturday, November 1st. This memo serves to guide all priests and deacons as well as pastors and their liturgical ministers as they prepare for these celebrations.

1. *All Saints' Day*: in accord with canon 1246 §2 of the *Code of Canon Law* and the Complimentary Norms for the (arch)dioceses of the United States of America, the obligation to attend Mass on this day does not exist this year. Keeping in mind that the liturgical day runs from midnight to midnight (*Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar*, 3) and that All Saints' «just» outranks the *Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed*, **the evening Masses of Saturday, November 1st are of All Saints', not of All Souls'**. It is important to remember that the obligation for Sunday Mass attendance is fulfilled for those who attend Saturday evening masses in accordance with the prescriptions of canon 1248 §1. Where fulfilling the offices of the *Liturgy of the Hours* is concerned, Vespers on Saturday evening is Evening Prayer II from All Saints' and Compline is taken from *After Evening Prayer II on Sundays and Solemnities*.
2. *All Souls' Day*: all masses of Sunday, November 2nd are of *The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed*. It is important to remember that on All Souls' Day, any priest may celebrate three masses. Since All Souls' falls on a Sunday, **the offices of the Liturgy of the Hours are taken from the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time** (the current Sunday and **not** the Office of the Dead). Compline is taken from *After Evening Prayer II on Sundays and Solemnities*.
3. *The Dedication of St. John Lateran*: as a Feast of the Lord, *The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica* outranks that of a Sunday of Ordinary Time. Ordinarily, the liturgical grade of a feast is celebrated within the limits of the liturgical day – meaning it does not have either First Vespers or a Vigil Mass. When a Feast of the Lord falls on a Sunday in Ordinary Time, it does (cf. *Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar*, 13). This means that both **the Vigil Masses of Saturday, November 8th and Masses of Sunday, November 9th are of St. John Lateran**. This has consequences for the celebration of the *Liturgy of the Hours*. On Saturday, November 8th, Vespers is taken from the *Common of the Dedication of a Church*, *Evening Prayer I* (outside the dedicated church). Compline is taken as usual from *After Evening Prayer I on Sundays and Solemnities*. The offices of Sunday are from the feast itself.
