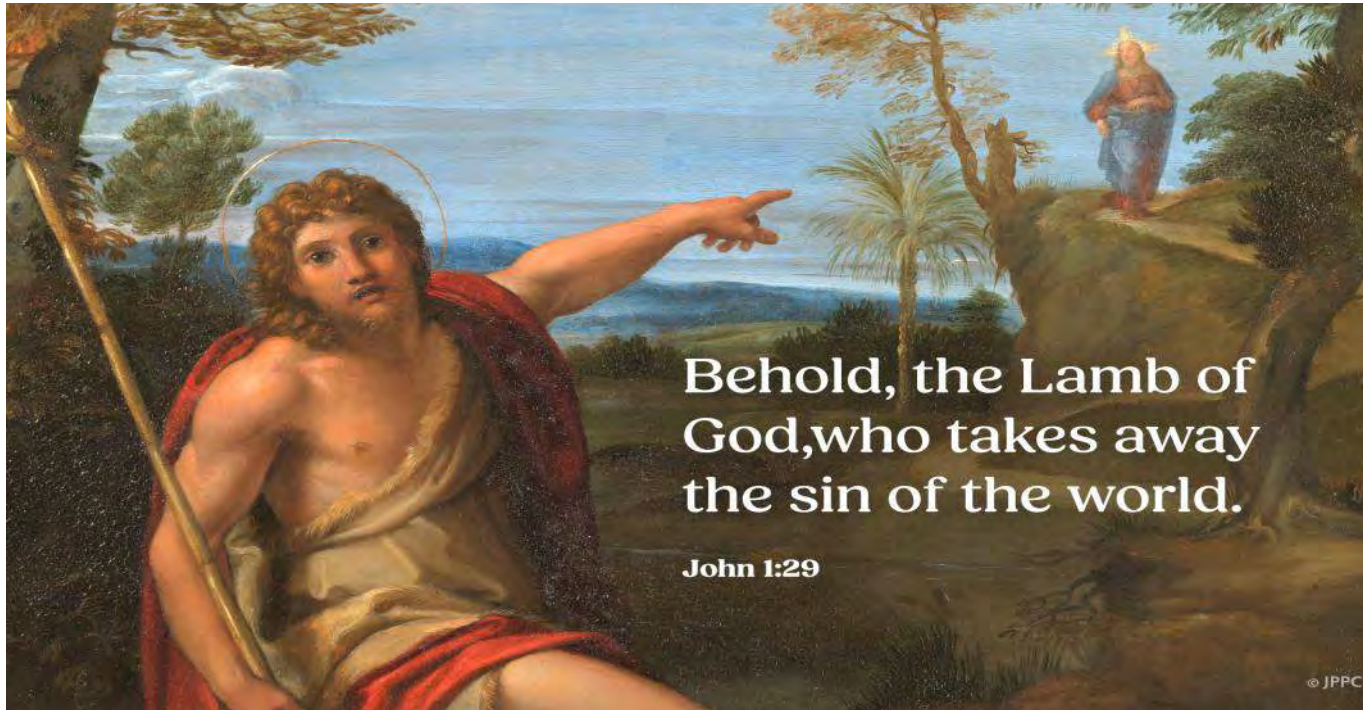

2025 Bishop's Appeal as of 1/9/26

Sacred Heart, Greenwich raised 175 gifts worth \$39,528 from 141 donors bringing the Parish to 108.30% of its \$36,500 goal. \$38,668 has been collected in cash which is 105.94% of goal.
